Economic Impact Report: Woodloch Pines

Founded in 1999, **For Pete's Sake Cancer Respite Foundation** offers no-cost respites for cancer patients and their families, complementing medical treatment. After helping over 12,000 people, FPS launched a \$25 million campaign in 2021 to build the nation's first dedicated Cancer Respite Center adjacent to Woodloch Pines in Northeastern Pennsylvania.
